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THE RENTING ORGANIZATION/INDIVIDUAL (Renter) AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING POLICIES WHICH APPLY TO ALL RENTALS IN FACILITIES OPERATED BY THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF BAY COUNTY (BGCBC).

1. The person or persons signing the contract must be 21 years of age and are the responsible parties.
2. BGCBC will not be responsible for any personal injury or damage, nor theft or loss of personal possessions or equipment of the renting party or guests of rental party. Renter shall indemnify and save harmless BGCBC, its directors, and officers against all claims and demands whatsoever by any person or entity, whether in respect of damage to person or property, including theft, arising out of use of BGCBC facilities.
3. The Renter is responsible for all the BGCBC property and agrees to reimburse BGCBC for any damage to property, including theft, arising out of usage of BGCBC facilities.
4. The Renter and guests (participants) are to use only the areas agreed to in this contract; use of other areas of the facility may result in termination of rental and forfeiture of all fees.
5. Unsupervised children are not allowed in any facility during rental and BGCBC will not be responsible for their safety.
6. The Renter and guests (participants) will follow all pool rules and follow Life Guards' directions that pertain to pool safety, weather, emergencies, and other situations.
7. Renter is responsible for cleaning the area rented and to leave it in an orderly fashion. \$25 deposit will be forfeited if not complied with.
8. Parking will not be allowed anywhere but in designated parking areas. Access to unload and load equipment is permitted, but vehicles must be parked in the designated areas.
9. Drugs, alcoholic beverages, and weapons are not allowed in or on BGCBC property.
10. Smoking is not allowed in BGCBC buildings or on property.
11. All requests for equipment and/or services will be made at the time the rental agreement is signed. This includes equipment such as tables, chairs, staging, lighting, or public address systems. Furniture, fixtures, and equipment are not to be moved from the pool area without the explicit approval of BGCBC. Applicable fees may be charged for these additions.
12. BGCBC requires a 48-hour cancellation notice in writing.
13. In the event that BGCBC shall be obligated or hindered or prevented from providing the use of the facilities for any reason not the fault of BGCBC, BGCBC shall be excused from delivery of the facilities as otherwise herein provided without further liability.
14. A copy of this agreement will be kept on file and a copy given to the renting organization or individual.

Aquatic Center Rental Agreement

Pool Rules

- 1. Do not enter the water unless a lifeguard is on duty.**
- 2. Shower before entering the water.**
- 3. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.**
- 4. Pushing, pulling, or rough play is not allowed in the pool area.**
- 5. Glass containers, food, drink, and animals are not allowed in the pool area.**
- 6. No smoking or vaping is allowed in the pool area or any Boys & Girls Clubs property.**
- 7. No inner tubes, rafts, or other flotation devices allowed.**
- 8. Please report all accidents & injuries to the lifeguard.**
- 9. The lifeguard may require a “time out” period, or possible ejection from the pool for any unsafe practice or rule violations.**
- 10. Appropriate swim wear must be worn, INCLUDING SWIM DIAPERS.**
- 11. Absolutely NO DIVING, NO RUNNING, AND NO FLIPS**
